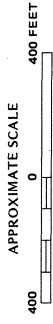

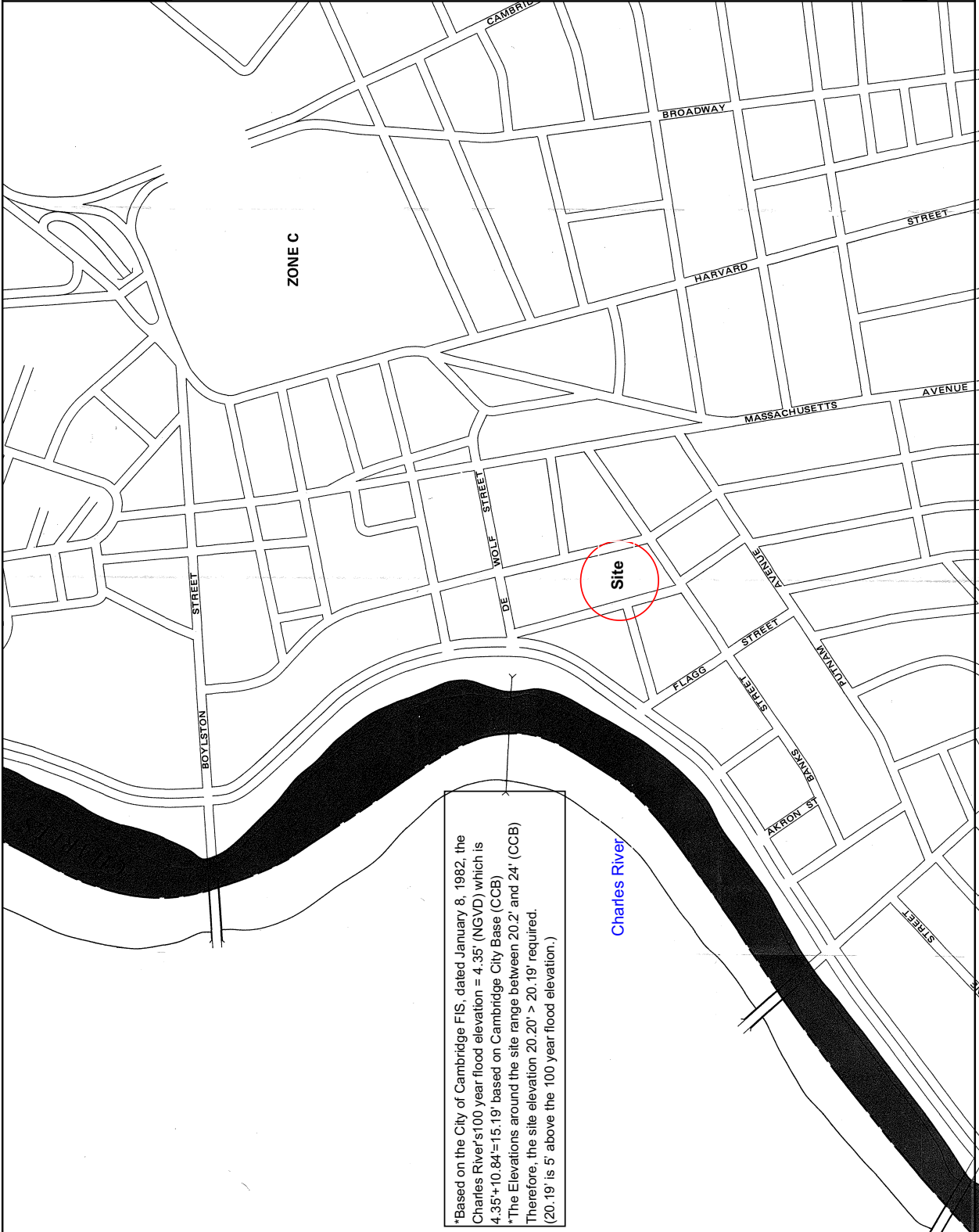

Charles River

\*Based on the City of Cambridge FIS, dated January 8, 1982, the Charles River's 100 year flood elevation = 4.35' (NGVD) which is 4.35'+10.84'=15.19' based on Cambridge City Base (CCB)  
\*The Elevations around the site range between 20.2' and 24' (CCB)  
Therefore, the site elevation 20.20' > 20.19' required.  
(20.19' is 5' above the 100 year flood elevation.)
